been sent to the Region Secretary prior to the contest. The contest entry fee is \$450.00 per group. Area Entry Fee is \$300.00.

PARKING: Bus and Truck parking will be on the South side of the stadium, nearest to the entrance gate. Please follow directions from the

attendants assisting with the parking procedures. Spectator parking will be on the North side of the stadium. THIS WILL BE THE

SAME PROCESS USED FOR THE SISD MARCHFEST.

TICKETS: Admission charge is \$5.00 for all spectators, six years old and older. Gates will open one hour before the contest start time.

Hometown Ticketing will be utilized once again.

RATINGS: Ratings will be announced at the end of each classification. There will NOT be any retreats. One director may enter the press box

to pick up the ratings packets following their bands performance.

FORMS: Band Directors must have the following forms on file prior to your band's performance:

WARM UP: We will be utilizing four (4) warm up areas. No one will be allowed to warm up *before* their assigned time. No one will be

allowed to warm up *past* their assigned time. We will be utilizing a flag system to allow for plenty of warm up time.

White flag up: playing allowed, including percussion.

Red flag up: NO playing allowed.

Please keep track of the flags and follow directions from the contest personnel working in the warmup area!

During the two-minute exit period of the previous performing band, the next band will move to the goal line. The front ensemble will move to the 20-yard line. YOU MUST WAIT AT THE GOAL LINE UNTIL YOU HEAR THE ANNOUNCEMENT THAT

YOUR BAND HAS FIVE MINUTES TO PREPARE. The five-minute clock will begin when this announcement has been made.

- When the 5:00 minute clock shows :45 the announcement will begin.
- The 8:00 minute clock will begin when the full 5:00 minutes of set-up time expires.
- Judges will be instructed to not begin judging until the 8:00 minute performance clock shows 7:59.
- The 2:00 minute field exit clock will start when it is apparent to the clock operator that the show is over.
- When your show is over, please move Front Ensemble off the field, to the lane closest to the bleachers to give the next ensemble room to set up!

VIDEO: UIL will NOT provide a video; however, a designated area for videographer will be provided. Make sure your videographer has a

copy of your Educational Use form!

POWER: Electrical outlets are located along the wall at the bottom of the bleachers. No extension cords will be provided. All set up time

for sideline equipment must be included in your official 15 minutes of field time.

WIRELESS: The wireless system at the SAC will be turned off for this contest.

CONTEST HQ: The Contest office will be in the Press Box. Access is available via the elevator or the door at the top of the bleachers.

School Administrators will be sent an email with a ticket for the contest.
